DFW CONNECTOR PROJECT: MAIN STREET BRIDGE CLOSURE

NorthGate Constructors to demo west side of Main Street Bridge

IRVING (April 6, 2010) — Beginning April 7, 2010, NorthGate Constructors will close Main Street Bridge during off peak hours for demolition of the west side.

The following full closures will be in place:

- **Wednesday, April 7 and Thursday, April 8:** From 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM the following morning both days, Main Street Bridge will be closed for lane restriping and placement of barrier wall and signage.
- **Friday, April 9:** From 8:00 PM to 9:00 AM the following morning, Main Street Bridge, westbound SH 114 near Main Street and southbound SH 121 at the SH 114 interchange will be closed.
- **Saturday, April 10:** From 8:00 PM to 9:00 AM the following morning, Main Street Bridge, eastbound SH 114 near Main Street and northbound SH 121 at the SH 114 interchange will be closed.
- **Sunday, April 11:** From 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM the following morning, the left lane of the eastbound SH 114 frontage road near Main Street will be closed for debris removal.

From April 7 through April 11 Main Street Bridge detours are through **Texan Trail or William D. Tate Avenue**, and SH114 detours are along frontage roads. While the west side of the bridge is removed, all traffic will be shifted to the east side.

The \$1.02 billion DFW Connector project is being built under a comprehensive development agreement (CDA) between TxDOT and NorthGate Constructors. The CDA allows for NorthGate Constructors to design and build the project simultaneously, shortening the time needed to deliver the project.

This 8-mile initial phase of the project will improve safety, mobility and air quality by doubling roadway capacity, with the addition of new general purpose lanes, toll managed lanes and continuous frontage roads. The project will be complete by 2014. Remaining portions of the total 14.4-mile project are unfunded.
