## DFW CONNECTOR TO REACH PROJECT MILESTONE

NorthGate Constructors to move traffic to the new east side of William D. Tate Bridge

**GRAPEVINE (November 2, 2011)** — This weekend, NorthGate Constructors will move traffic to the new east side of the William D. Tate Bridge.

In order to move traffic to the new construction and complete intersections work, the following closures will be in effect *continuously* from 8 PM on Friday, November 4 to 6 AM Monday, November 7:

### **8 PM on Friday, November 4 to 6 AM on Monday, November 7:**

1. **Full road closure** on the eastbound SH 114 frontage road east of William D. Tate Avenue; traffic will be detoured to Texan Trail.
2. **Full road closure** on the westbound SH 114 frontage road west of William D. Tate Avenue; westbound SH 114 frontage road traffic will be detoured to Ira E. Woods.
3. **Full ramp closure** on the northbound SH 121 off-ramp to William D. Tate Avenue/Main Street; traffic will be detoured to Texan Trail.
4. William D. Tate Bridge will be reduced to two lanes. *One lane will remain open in each direction.*
5. The westbound SH 114 frontage road from Main Street to William D. Tate Avenue will be reduced to one lane.

***All business access will be maintained while this traffic switch is in process.*** Motorists are reminded to drive carefully and pay attention to all signage.

Once traffic is switched to the new side of the bridge, construction will begin on the new west side of the bridge. The William D. Tate Bridge is expected to be completed in summer 2012.

The \$1.02 billion DFW Connector project is being built under a comprehensive development agreement between TxDOT and NorthGate Constructors allowing for NorthGate to design and build the project simultaneously, shortening the time needed to deliver the project.
